## Year 5 Visit to 'The Globe Theatre' – Friday 1st March

We are delighted to announce our trip to Shakespeare's Globe Theatre on **Friday 1**<sup>st</sup> **March**. During the course of the trip, children will tour The Globe itself as well as taking part in a specially tailored workshop with The Globe staff all about 'A Midsummer Night's Dream', the play that we will be studying this term.

The cost of the workshop and tour will be £14.00. In an effort to keep costs low, however, we will be travelling using public transport. Please arrange for your child to arrive at Hayes Station no later than 9.15am. School staff will be ready to receive pupils in the foyer of the station from 9.00am. Once in London, a short walk from London Bridge Station will see us complete our journey. School uniform should be worn with trainers. If the forecast is wet, the children will need to wear a waterproof jacket. The children **do not** need any money for souvenirs on this occasion.

In order to cover the cost of the trip, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £14.00 per pupil. Please note that whilst this is a voluntary contribution, if we do not receive sufficient contributions then the trip may have to be cancelled. Also, as the total cost of the visit is split equally across all pupils in the party, we are unable to provide refunds in the event of your child's non-attendance. Payments should be made under the Trips section on Arbor and should be made no later than <u>Friday</u> <u>23<sup>rd</sup> February</u>. You will also be able to give consent for the trip using Arbor, rather than returning a paper slip.

Please provide your child with a refillable water bottle and healthy packed lunch in a reusable bag or small rucksack (**no lunch boxes, glass bottles, nuts** or **sweets** please). Please provide your child with a small snack that they can eat on our arrival in London. Children will need to be collected from Hayes Station; we anticipate arriving back at around 2.45 p.m. Hopefully, that will allow any siblings to be collected from school afterwards.
