Dear Parents and Carers,

We have been invited to attend a Junior Citizen Scheme morning on Wednesday 14th June, held at Bromley Town Football Club, Hayes Lane. The sessions being run for the children include Police, Fire Brigade, First Aid, Safer Transport Team and Bromley Football Club will be doing a session on Keeping Healthy.

The session runs from 9.45 to 11.45 so to ensure that we keep costs to a minimum, we will be asking parents and carers to drop the children off at **Norman Park**, in the **Hayes Lane car park** (BR2 9EF). The children would need to be dropped off no later than 9.30, though staff will be ready to receive pupils from 9.10. Hopefully, this will allow plenty of time for any siblings to be dropped off at school beforehand without too much inconvenience. The Norman Park car park is through a set of gates and up along the driveway. **DO NOT** drop the children off at Bromley Town Football Club – no staff will be there to meet them.

After the session has finished, we will walk back round to Norman Park where we will sit and eat lunch. There will also be time for the children to have some free time (using school equipment provided) before we start walking back to school. We aim to return by the middle of the school afternoon so there will be no change to normal end-of-day routines for the children.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch with them (in a small bag that they will need to carry themselves) in accordance with the school policy, i.e. no nut products, no cans or fizzy drinks and no sweets. If your child normally has a school lunch, please ensure they have a lunch with them as we will not be back in school in time for lunch. They will also need to bring water with them in a named, reusable bottle as there will be no refreshments offered at the venue during the morning's session.

There is a chance we may need a couple of additional adults to support us at the event and the walk back to school. Please could you indicate whether you would be available to help out, should it be needed. If you do not hear from us during the week prior to the event, please assume that you are not needed.

Please return the reply slip as soon as possible – we are sending this out now due to PGL happening straight after half term! If you have any questions regarding the visit, please speak to either Year 6 teacher.
